Criteria

Individuals who meet the following criteria are eligible for the Icahn Automotive Technician Scholarship. The individuals must:

- At the time of application be (i) enrolled full-time at a US high school; or (ii) accepted or currently enrolled, either full-time or part-time, at an accredited college, university or trade school within the US. Trade school should be the equivalent of a two-year associate program.
- Be in pursuit of an automotive technician degree or certification (or equivalent degree/certification).
- Carry a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- Be a legal resident of the United States, in the United States on a student visa or a resident alien.
- Submit most recent transcript of all academic work.
- Submit a completed application which can be found at www.IcahnAutomotive.com/scholarships.
- Submit two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members.
- Submit a typed essay (no more than four (4) pages in length, double spaced – 1000 words maximum) OR a video (no more than two (2) minutes long) describing “why I want to be a top technician.”
